PROJECT DESCRIPTION

On December 17, 2019, NGF closed on a new loan to CRCD, Icon Commercial Contractors, and the Amity Foundation to finance the acquisition and rehabilitation of a former residential hotel into a 95-unit permanent supportive housing development for transition-age youth ("TAY"), veterans, and other low-income adults who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. The proposed rehab will involve the redesign of the original floor plans to include 95 residential units. The rehab scope will include necessary seismic upgrades and comply with ADA requirements. All affordable units will be designed as studios with full bathrooms and kitchens. The building will incorporate community rooms, supportive service spaces, meeting rooms and management offices.
